



Handing a door is most easily done when you are standing on the side of the door where the hinge pins are visible.

For doors that swing into a space (or inswing doors), when standing on the hinge pin side of the door, determine which side the door knob is on. When the knob is on the right side of the door, the door is a **RIGHT HAND** door. When the knob is on the left side of the door, the door is **LEFT HAND**.

For outswing doors, or doors that open to the outside, the hinge pins will always be on the outside and the nomenclature is a bit different. Again, when standing on the side of the door where the hinge pins are visible, determine the location of the door knob or handle. when the handle is on the right, the door is **LEFT HAND REVERSE**. When the handle is on the left the doors is a **RIGHT HAND REVERSE**.
